Using the above online service, the investigating officer of any state or law enforcement agency in the country can register online any investigation cooperation related request involving cyber criminals, having any links in Jharkhand. All the requests registered via this online service are being attended to by us on priority basis and the results communicated via e-mail/phone.

The posting of requests by various states on this online portal has helped us in collecting actionable information regarding cyber criminals and taking decisive action against them besides helping the concerned state in solving their crime.
